

JOLLY JUMP OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

DO NOT OPERATE THE JOLLY JUMP IN WINDY OR UNFAVORABLE WEATHER CONDITIONS. JOLLY JUMPS CAN TURN OVER IN HIGH WINDS SEVERELY INJURING OCCUPANTS.

Make sure that the JOLLY JUMP is fully inflated before letting riders inside. Never allow riders on a partially inflated unit. All riders must remove their shoes and empty their pockets of any hard objects that can injure themselves or others while jumping. Eyeglasses and jewelry should also be removed. This includes watches, bracelets, necklaces, earrings, etc.

Riders should all be of the same age group and should be limited to the maximum number of riders shown below. Never allow more riders in the unit than as shown. The unit must be supervised by a competent adult at all times.

Capacity:	Under 5 years	6-8 years old	9-13 years old	Older teens

In the event of severe weather, remove all riders from the unit and unplug immediately.

Make sure the unit remains securely anchored. Do not re-inflate unit until adverse weather conditions cease. When conditions permit, inflate unit and allow it to dry before using again. Never allow playing on a wet unit.

If the JOLLY JUMP becomes unplugged or loses power during operations, the attendant should hold open door and allow the riders to exit. There is no cause for alarm, riders should be told to remain calm and follow the attendant's instructions.

RULES

General Rules for safe operation

- A. No flips
- B. No rough play of climbing on the net walls
- C. No shoes in inflatable
- D. No sharp objects in or around the inflatable
- E. No food, drinks or gum in or around the inflatable
- F. **MUST BE SUPERVISED**
- G. Children of the same age group must play in the inflatable at the same time...Do not mix age groups.
- H. Do not exceed the recommended capacity
- I. No eyeglasses or jewelry
- J. No silly string in or around the inflatable

Renter must provide a person 16 years or older to operate this ride at all times.
Customer is responsible for any permits.

ADDITIONAL RENTAL CONTRACT AND CONDITIONS FOR BOUNCE HOUSE

- Please read operating instructions carefully.
- Never place on hard surface. Grass or Dirt only
- A deposit equivalent to 1/3 of the rental is required for all reservations
- All deposits are non refundable. If you reserve an outdoor event you should have rain date (within the same weekend)
- If the unit is picked up from our store, or delivered to your site, you are liable for making payment in full whether the unit is used or not
- This unit must be plugged into a GFI (Ground Force Interrupt) outlet
- Do not use in inclement weather conditions (high winds, rain, etc.)
- Do not expose fan to water or rain
- Be advised this unit cannot be operated in the rain for reasons of slippery surfaces, electrical shock hazard, etc.
- Renter must personally inspect unit and notify A-1 Tents & Party Rentals immediately of any defects prior to use.
- When finished with unit for the day, please deflate according to instruction booklet attached and put in secure area away from wind and rain.
- Children should not be left unattended at any time. An attendant of 18 years or older must be present and supervise the operation of the bounce house at all times.
- No one under the age of 18 years should be allowed to operate or supervise this bounce house.
- No more than 5 children at a time should be in this unit.
- Deflation should be done by a responsible adult only.
- Please use stakes/pegs provided to properly secure bounce house (See Manual for installations)
- In case of personal injury or damages to our equipment, while in the renter's possession, renter hereby expressly agrees to assume responsibility for himself, his own employees, agents and assigns negligence and agrees to indemnify, defend and hold rental center (A-1 Tents & Party Rentals, Inc.) harmless from any claims or actions arising there from. Renter's insurance covering such loss or damage shall be used. The renter will exercise all rights available to him under said insurance.
